

Existing law authorizes parish governing authorities to create or enlarge fire protection districts.

Existing law provides generally that fire protection districts are governed by a board of commissioners that are appointed by the parish governing authority if no municipality is included within the boundaries of a district.

Prior law established the governing board of the Bayou Cane Fire Protection District to consist of five members.

New law authorizes the governing authority of Terrebonne Parish to increase membership of the governing board of the Bayou Cane Fire Protection District from five to seven and provides that the parish governing authority shall appoint such additional members and provide for their initial terms.

Effective August 1, 2013.
