AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 14:95.5(C), relative to the crime of possession of a firearm on the premises of an alcoholic beverage outlet; to provide an exception for certain concealed handgun permit holders and certain active duty and retired law enforcement officers; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 14:95.5(C) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§95.5. Possession of firearm on premises of alcoholic beverage outlet

* * *

~~C.(1)~~ The provisions of this Section shall not apply to the owner or lessee of an alcoholic beverage outlet, ~~or~~ to an employee of such owner or lessee, or to a law enforcement officer or other person vested with law enforcement authority ~~acting in the performance of his official duties~~ **or listed in R.S. 14:95(G).**

(2) The provisions of this Section shall not apply to a person possessing a firearm in accordance with a concealed handgun permit issued pursuant to R.S. 40:1379.1 or 1379.3 while on the premises of an alcoholic beverage outlet that has been issued a Class A-Restaurant permit, as defined in Part II of
