Amendments proposed by Representative Thompson to Engrossed House Bill No. 1066 by Representative Thompson

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "(17)" delete the remainder of the line, insert a comma "," and insert  
3 "(K), and (T)(1), relative to qualifications for"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 5, after "permit;" and before "and" insert "to provide for penalties for using  
6 a suspended or revoked concealed handgun permit to purchase a firearm;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 8, after "(17)" delete the remainder of the line, insert a comma "," and insert  
9 insert "(K), and (T)(1) are hereby amended and reenacted"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 2, after line 20, insert the following:

12 "T.(1) Possession of a current and valid concealed handgun permit issued pursuant  
13 to this Section shall constitute sufficient evidence of the background check required pursuant  
14 to 18 U.S.C. 922(t) provided that the appropriate waiver has been granted by the Bureau of  
15 Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives. A person whose permit has been suspended or  
16 revoked by the department and who uses that permit to purchase a firearm from a licensed  
17 dealer knowing that the permit has been suspended or revoked shall be fined not more than  
18 five hundred dollars or imprisoned for not more than six months, or both.
