21 thereof a period "."22 AMENDMENT NO. 823 On page 3, delete lines 26 through 28 and on page 4, delete lines 1 and 2 and insert in lieu  
24 thereof:25 "(4) Except as provided in Subsection B of this Section, allocate all  
26 funds available to the school system to individual schools on a per-pupil  
27 basis. Allocation of funds received via the Minimum Foundation Program  
28 shall be allocated per-pupil according to weights for special characteristics  
29 or needs as provided in the Minimum Foundation Program formula. All  
30 unrestricted funds shall be allocated per-pupil according to weights for  
31 special characteristics or needs as determined to be equitable by the local  
32 school board. All funds subject to use restrictions shall be allocated per pupil  
33 in such a way as to fulfill their restricted use, as deemed equitable by the  
34 local school board."

1 AMENDMENT NO. 9

2 On page 4, line 11, after "R.S. 17:134." add "Enrollment zone policies shall include  
3 provisions that limit mid-year enrollment changes caused by student change in address."

4 AMENDMENT NO. 10

5 On page 4, line 13, between "retain" and "a" insert "revenue for payment of retiree legacy  
6 costs, construction, maintenance, and repair of immovable property, and bonded  
7 indebtedness, and, in addition, shall annually retain"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 11

9 On page 4, line 16, after "Section" delete the comma "," and delete the remainder of the line  
10 and insert in lieu thereof a period "." and "Retained funds shall be used for their intended  
11 purpose."

12 AMENDMENT NO. 12

13 On page 4, line 26, between "and" and "goals" change "accountability" to "performance"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 13

15 On page 5, delete lines 7 through 19, and insert in lieu thereof:

16 "(10) Provide support and operations services for schools on a  
17 charge-back basis, including but not limited to: student food services, student  
18 transportation services, financial and accounting services, student appraisal  
19 for special education services, student transportation services, special  
20 services for at-risk students, special education services other than gifted and  
21 talented, gifted and talented student services, custodial and maintenance  
22 services, media services, technology services, library services, student health  
23 services, and health benefits for active employees. Prior to the start of each  
24 school year, the superintendent shall provide to each principal an invoice  
25 detailing the itemized per-unit cost of all support and operations services the  
26 superintendent may provide to the principal's school during that school year.  
27 The principal may opt out of any service provided by the superintendent via  
28 a written notification, and then retain one hundred percent of the cost of such  
29 service as part of the school's operating budget. Annually, the superintendent  
30 shall prepare and submit to each principal a written report detailing the actual  
31 cost of the services provided to the school and shall prepare and submit a  
32 summary of this report to the school board."

33 AMENDMENT NO. 14

34 On page 5, between lines 23 and 24, insert:

35 "(14) Annually create and submit to the local school board a report  
36 of district progress which shall include but not be limited to data on student  
37 growth, student achievement, number and percentage of students enrolled in  
38 and any excess capacity in schools meeting statewide proficiency standards,  
39 enrollment trends including transfers into and out of the school system from  
40 and to private schools, excess demand and capacity for each available  
41 magnet, special education, alternative, and each other special program, and  
42 satisfaction of parents, guardians, teachers, and principals.

43 (15) Provide administrative guidelines to principals concerning  
44 relevant laws, policies, and regulations.

1                   (16) Work with principals and the community to strategically map  
2                   programs in local schools to ensure adequate availability of special education  
3                   programs.

6   On page 5, line 28, between "for" and "goals" change "clear accountability" to  
7   "performance"

8   AMENDMENT NO. 16

9   On page 6, delete lines 3 and 4, and insert in lieu thereof "duration of each management  
10 contract shall be no more than two years, and management contracts may be terminated for  
11 failure to meet the performance goals specified in the contract and for willful neglect of  
12 duty, incompetency, dishonesty, or immorality. No principal shall suffer any disciplinary  
13 action for exercising any right or power or performing any duty or function granted or  
14 authorized for principals by this Subpart."

15   AMENDMENT NO. 17

16   On page 6, line 20, between "at least" and "community-based" change "three" to "five"

17   AMENDMENT NO. 18

18   On page 6, line 27, after "(3)" delete the remainder of the line and insert in lieu thereof  
19   "Charter schools located within the geographical boundaries of the school system shall be  
20   included as an"

21   AMENDMENT NO. 19

22   On page 6, line 24, between "programs" and "and special" insert a comma "," and  
23   "alternative schools and programs."

24   AMENDMENT NO. 20

25   On page 6, below line 29, insert:

26                   "(4) The enrollment system shall not assign a child to any school  
27                   system, charter, or Recovery School District school. If a student's parent or  
28                   legal guardian fails to choose a school through the enrollment system, the  
29                   school system shall assign the student to a school with excess capacity."

30   AMENDMENT NO. 21

31   On page 7, at the end of line 2, delete "chief executive" and at the beginning of line 3, delete  
32   "officer." and insert in lieu thereof "leader."

33   AMENDMENT NO. 22

36                   by creation and implementation of policies and procedures related to student  
37                   discipline and to health and safety for students, teachers, and other school

39                   (4) Serving as the school's instructional leader, tailoring instructional  
40                   activities to the unique needs of the school's student population, including  
41                   development or purchase of a standards-based school curriculum and related  
42                   training, determining and implementing instruction methods, materials, and

1 support, choosing examinations and assessments except as otherwise  
2 required by law, determining the school schedule, engaging instructional  
3 staff in sharing information, analyzing outcomes, and directing improvement,  
4 and providing feedback to instructional staff in the form of data and  
5 evaluations.

6 (5) Managing school resources and procurement to address the  
7 unique needs of the school's student population, tailoring purchases of  
8 materials, products and services and managing other resources as appropriate  
9 for fostering positive student outcomes. Principals may work  
10 collaboratively, pooling resources and funds to jointly procure such  
11 materials, products, and services.

12 (6) Providing public information about the school through news  
13 media and other forms of communication to the school's community."

15 On page 7, line 25, change "(12) Compliance" to "(7) Complying"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 24

17 On page 7, between lines 25 and 26, insert:

18 "B. Principals may opt out of school system-provided support services as  
19 provided in R.S. 17:133(D)(10)."

20 AMENDMENT NO. 25

21 On page 7, at the beginning of line 26, change "B." to "C."

22 AMENDMENT NO. 26

23 On page 8, line 2, after "examinations," and before "the American" change "including but  
24 not limited to" to "such as"

25 AMENDMENT NO. 27

26 On page 8, between lines 14 and 15, insert:

27 "D. Principals may work collaboratively, pooling and sharing assets  
28 and resources including but not limited to:

- 29 (1) Funds.
- 30 (2) Personnel.
- 31 (3) Professional development tools.
- 32 (4) Instructional materials.
- 33 (5) Assessment tools or services.
- 34 (6) Learning technologies."

36 On page 8, line 18, between "zone." and "A" insert "Councils shall be advisory only."

38 On page 8, line 19, after "shall" delete the remainder of the line and insert in lieu thereof  
39 "have an advisory role, supporting principals by acting as an advocate for schools and  
40 engaging"

1 AMENDMENT NO. 30

2 On page 9, at the end of line 1, change "eleven" to "fifteen"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 31

4 On page 9, line 6, between "zone." and "member" delete "No" and insert in lieu thereof "In  
5 addition to the parent, guardian, community and business members, one teacher and one  
6 principal currently employed at a school or schools within the enrollment zone shall serve  
7 as members of the council. However, no other"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 32

9 On page 9, delete lines 18 and 19 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

10 "Section 2. The local school board of a large school system subject to the provisions  
11 of this Act shall require the superintendent of the school system to prepare for  
12 implementation of the provisions of this Act by July 1, 2017. The local school board shall  
13 require the superintendent to complete a plan for implementation of this Act and file a copy  
14 of the plan with the school board not later than August 1, 2015. The plan shall include  
15 provisions for implementation of all requirements of this Act and shall also include  
16 provisions for training for principals relative to principal empowerment. The plan may  
17 include provisions for implementation phases for particular provisions of the Act. Upon  
18 filing of the plan with the school board, the superintendent shall begin implementation.

19 Section 3. The provisions of this Act shall become effective on August 1, 2014. The  
20 Act shall be fully implemented not later than July 1, 2017."
