
SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs to Original Senate Bill No. 470 by Senator Martiny

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, delete lines 11 through 17 in their entirety and insert:

3 "H.**(1)(a)** In the event a person is not submitted to or is not confirmed by the Senate,
4 and the person attempts to remain in office **after being advised by the Senate,**
5 **through its president, by certified mail, return receipt requested of his lack of**
6 **confirmation,** and acts in his official capacity, any action taken by a public body in
7 which such person participates shall be null and void.

8 **(b)** The Senate, through its president, may bring an action to remove the person from
9 office. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the venue for any such action
10 shall be East Baton Rouge Parish.

11 **(2)(a) In the event a person is not reconfirmed by the Senate, pursuant to**
12 **Subsection K of this Section and the person attempts to remain in office after**
13 **being advised by the Senate through its president, by certified mail, return**
14 **receipt requested of his lack of confirmation and acts in his official capacity, any**
15 **action taken by a public body in which such person participates shall be a**
16 **relative nullity and shall be subject to challenge in district court.**
17 **Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the venue for any such action**
18 **shall be East Baton Rouge Parish.**

19 **(b) The Senate, through its president, may bring an action to remove the person**
20 **from office. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the venue for any**
21 **such action shall be East Baton Rouge Parish.**

22 AMENDMENT NO. 2

23 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 8 in their entirety and insert:

24 **(3) The Senate, through its president, shall notify any person who was not**
25 **submitted to the Senate, any person who was not confirmed or reconfirmed**
26 **pursuant to Subsection K of this Section, and the office, board, commission,**
27 **committee, or district to which the person was appointed no later than thirty**
28 **days after the Senate considers the confirmation.**
