Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

House Floor Amendments to the engrossed concurrent resolution.

Changed the requirement that the Dept. of Health and Hospitals amend LAC 48:V.6303 to add adrenoleukodystrophy to the mandatory screenings to be performed on a newborn child to a requirement that DHH submit a report to the House Health and Welfare Committee evaluating the health benefits and health care cost of adding adrenoleukodystrophy.
