**HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENTS**

Amendments proposed by Representative Carter to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 636 by Senator White

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, at the end of line 5, insert "**The legislature further finds that concurrent**  
 3 **existence of several smaller school systems and a large school system within a single**  
 4 **parish indicates a desire by the parish population to have more local control over the**  
 5 **parish's public schools.**"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 2

7 On page 3, between lines 3 and 4, insert the following:

8 **"(2) "Central office operations" means non-instructional support**  
 9 **services including general administration, business services, and central**  
 10 **services."**

11 AMENDMENT NO. 3

12 On page 3, at the beginning of line 4, change "(2)" to "(3)"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 4

14 On page 3, at the beginning of line 6, change "(3)" to "(4)"

15 AMENDMENT NO. 5

16 On page 3, at the beginning of line 8, change "(4)" to "(5)"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 6

18 On page 3, at the beginning of line 10, change "(5)" to "(6)"

19 AMENDMENT NO. 7

20 On page 3, at the beginning of line 13, change "(6)" to "(7)"

21 AMENDMENT NO. 8

22 On page 3, at the beginning of line 16, change "(7)" to "(8)"

23 AMENDMENT NO. 9

24 On page 4, delete lines 25 through 29, and on page 5, delete line 1, and insert the following:

25 **"B. The school system shall annually retain revenue for payment of**  
 26 **retiree legacy costs, construction, maintenance, and repair of immovable**  
 27 **property, bonded indebtedness, liability insurance, and contributions to any**  
 28 **pension accumulation fund, and shall annually retain a maximum of four and**

1 one-half percent of the school system's general fund revenue for expenditure for  
2 central office operations."

3 AMENDMENT NO. 10

4 On page 9, after line 29, insert the following:

5 "C. Prior to the beginning of the 2017-2018 school year, the provision of  
6 student transportation and student food services shall remain the responsibility  
7 of the school system through its central office. Principals exercising the powers  
8 or performing any duties or functions granted or authorized for principals by  
9 this Subpart shall not provide these services at the school level, but shall pay a  
10 per-pupil cost from their budget to the central office for provision of these  
11 services."
