

New law provides for the design and creation of a special prestige license plate for the La. AIDS Advocacy Network provided there is a minimum of 1,000 applicants.

New law provides that the prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application to any citizen of La., in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

New law provides for the secretary of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to work in conjunction with LAAN to select the color and design of the plate.

New law requires the department to collect an annual royalty fee of \$25 for each plate issued and specifies that such fees be collected by the department and forwarded to the LAAN. Specifies that monies received from the royalty fees shall be used solely for the support of programs administered by the LAAN. Further provides for the standard registration license fee and a handling fee of \$3.50 to be retained by the department to offset a portion of administrative costs.

New law requires the secretary to promulgate rules and regulations to implement the provisions provided in new law.

Effective August 1, 2014.
