1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 17:374(A)(2)(introductory paragraph), R.S. 25:341(D)(1)(e) and
3 799(C)(1)(g), R.S. 25:652(A), and R.S. 49:968(B) and (3)(c) and to repeal Part XV
4 of Chapter 5 of Title 3 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S.
5 3:558.1 through 558.13, R.S. 17:7(25), and Chapter 14 of Title 17 of the Louisiana
6 Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 17:2751 through 2759, R.S.
7 25:1226.1(7), 1226.2, 1226.4(B)(1), and Chapter 29 of Title 25 of the Louisiana
8 Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 25:1251 through 1255, R.S. 32:1751,
9 R.S. 36:4(L)(2), 209(M)(2) and (S), and 610(M), 629(R), 651(D)(6), and 802.17,
10 Part IV of Chapter 3 of Title 51 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950,
11 comprised of R.S. 51:955.1 through 955.4, and Part III of Chapter 2 of Title 56 of
12 the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 56:901, relative to boards,
13 commissions, authorities, districts, and like entities; to provide relative to the
14 functional organization of state government by abolishing certain boards,
15 commissions, councils, authorities, and like entities; to transfer certain powers,
16 functions, and duties; to remove references to certain abolished entities; to remove
17 references to, provisions for, and the powers, functions, and duties of the Atchafalaya
18 Trace Heritage Area Development Zone Review Board, Louisiana Broadband
19 Advisory Council, Louisiana Catfish Promotion and Research Program and Board,
20 Coastal Land Stewardship Authority, Mississippi River Road Commission, Systemic
21 Initiatives Program Council, and Tri-State Corridor Commission and the French
22 Quarter Management District; to provide for membership of the Louisiana State
23 Museum Board of Directors; to provide for membership of the Council for the
24 Development of French in Louisiana; and to provide for related matters.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

2 Section 1. The legislature finds that abolishing, transferring, and consolidating
3 certain boards, commissions, and other statutorily-created entities are in the public interest
4 when such entities no longer serve a public purpose. Pursuant to the recommendations
5 contained in the December 18, 2013, Legislative Auditor Report to the Legislature titled
6 "Boards, Commissions, and Like Entities" and other information, it is the intent of the
7 legislature to abolish, transfer, and consolidate boards, commissions, and other
8 statutorily-created entities as provided in this Act.

9 **Atchafalaya Trace Heritage Area Development Zone Review Board**

10 Section 2. R.S. 36:209(M)(2) and R.S. 25:1226.1(7), 1226.2, and 1226.4(B)(1) are
11 hereby repealed in their entirety.

12 **Broadband Advisory Council**

13 Section 3. R.S. 36:4(L)(2) and Part IV of Chapter 3 of Title 51 of the Louisiana
14 Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 51:955.1 through 955.4, are hereby repealed in
15 their entirety.

16 **Catfish Promotion and Research Program and Board**

17 Section 4. R.S. 36:629(R) and Part XV of Chapter 5 of Title 3 of the Louisiana
18 Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 3:558.1 through 558.13, are hereby repealed in
19 their entirety.

20 **Coastal Land Stewardship Authority**

21 Section 5. R.S. 36:610(M) and Part III of Chapter 2 of Title 56 of the Louisiana
22 Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 56:901, are hereby repealed in their entirety.

23 Section 6. R.S. 25:341(D)(1)(e) and 799(C)(1)(g) are hereby amended and reenacted
24 to read as follows:

16 Section 7.(A) R.S. 49:968(B) and (3)(c) are hereby amended and reenacted to read
17 as follows:

18 §968. Review of agency rules; fees

19 * * *

20 B. Prior to the adoption, amendment, or repeal of any rule or the adoption,
21 ~~increasing~~ increase, or ~~decreasing~~ decrease of any fee, the agency shall submit a
22 report relative to such proposed rule change or fee adoption, increase, or decrease to
23 the appropriate standing committees of the legislature and the presiding officers of
24 the respective houses as provided in this Section. The report shall be so submitted
25 on the same day the notice of the intended action is submitted to the Louisiana
26 Register for publication in accordance with R.S. 49:953(A)(1). The report shall be
27 submitted to each standing committee electronically if electronic means are
28 available. If no electronic means are available, the report shall be submitted ~~at~~ to the
29 committee's office in the state capitol by certified mail with return receipt requested
30 or by messenger who shall provide a receipt for signature. The electronic receipt by

1 the committee, return receipt or the messenger's receipt shall be proof of receipt of
2 the report by the committee.

5 agencies made a part of it, except as otherwise provided in this Paragraph, shall
6 submit the report to the House Committee on Municipal, Parochial and Cultural

1 superintendent of education, and two members of each of the following organizations
2 chosen by the organization:

8 Section 9. R.S. 25:652(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

9 §652. Membership; appointment; terms; vacancies; compensation

10 A. The council shall be composed of twenty-three members as follows:

11 (1) Two members appointed by the governor.

12 (2) ~~Four~~ Three members appointed by the Louisiana section of the
13 Assemblée des Parlementaires Francophones.

14 (3) Two members appointed by the council's Consortium of Louisiana
15 Colleges and Universities.

16 (4) One member appointed by the Le Centre International de Lafayette.

17 (5) One member appointed by the Louisiana Cultural Economy Foundation.

18 (6) The mayor of New Orleans, or his designee.

19 (7) One member appointed by the French-American Chamber of Commerce,
20 Louisiana Chapter.

21 (8) One member appointed by the Louisiana Educational Television
22 Authority.

23 (9) One member appointed by La Fondation Louisiane.

24 (10) Four members appointed by the Louisiana Consortium of Immersion
25 Schools.

26 (11) ~~Two members~~ One member appointed by the American Association of
27 Teachers of French, Louisiana Chapter.

28 (12) One member appointed by the United Houma Nation.

29 (13) One member appointed by the Association Louisiane-Acadie.
