13 WHEREAS, Specialist Chase McRay Reynolds was highly successful after joining
14 the Louisiana Army National Guard in 2013, and becoming an infantryman with D
15 Company, 2nd Battalion, 256th Infantry Brigade located in Thibodaux, Louisiana; and

16 WHEREAS, Specialist Reynolds always made time to spend with his family and
17 never failed to step in and assist others when they needed his help or wisdom in times of
18 difficulty; and

1 WHEREAS, his gift for inspiring his younger brothers and others with his love,
2 understanding, and strong personality, was cut short August 2, 2014, when he passed away
3 suddenly at the age of twenty; and
