SENATE. Designates May 2015 as Building Safety Month.

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To recognize May 2015 as "Building Safety Month".

3 WHEREAS, for the past thirty-five years, the International Code Council has
4 celebrated advances in constructing safe, sustainable, affordable, and resilient buildings and
5 homes; and

6 WHEREAS, the International Code Council utilizes a governmental consensus
7 process that coordinates local, state, and federal officials with expertise in the building
8 environment to create and implement building codes of the highest quality to protect
9 Americans in the buildings where they live, learn, work, worship, and play; and

10 WHEREAS, the International Codes are the most widely adopted building safety,
11 energy, and fire prevention codes in the United States and include safeguards to protect the
12 public from natural disasters such as hurricanes, snow storms, tornadoes, wildfires, floods,
13 and earthquakes; and

14 WHEREAS, "Building Safety Month" was founded by the International Code
15 Council and is celebrated worldwide during the month of May as a public awareness
16 campaign to help individuals, families, and businesses understand the process of creating
17 safe and sustainable structures; and

18 WHEREAS, the campaign is presented by the International Code Council and its
