6 "D. Nothing in this Part shall be construed to create any right of  
7 discrimination between private persons, but the provisions of this Part are  
8 instead intended to prevent, notwithstanding any other law to the contrary,  
9 this state from taking an adverse action against a person, wholly or partially,  
10 on the basis that such person acts in accordance with a sincerely held  
11 religious belief or moral conviction that marriage is or should be recognized  
12 as the union of one man and one woman."
