AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 47:463.4(M), relative to motor vehicles; to provide relative to the definition of a "medical examiner" for issuance of special license plates or hang tags for mobility impaired persons; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 47:463.4(M) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§463.4. Special license plates or hang tags for persons with mobility impairments

* * *

M. The term "medical examiner" as used in this Section shall mean a person licensed to practice medicine ~~by the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners in~~ **Louisiana or any other state or territory of the United States**, a person licensed to practice chiropractic by the Louisiana State Board of Chiropractic Examiners, a person licensed by the Louisiana State Board of Physical Therapy Examiners, or advanced practice registered nurses.

Present law defines the term "medical examiner" to mean a person licensed to practice medicine by the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners, a person licensed to practice chiropractic by the Louisiana State Board of Chiropractic Examiners, a person licensed by the Louisiana State Board of Physical Therapy Examiners, or advanced practice registered nurses.

Proposed law modifies present law to include a person licensed to practice medicine in Louisiana or any other state or territory of the United States.

Effective August 1, 2016.
