20 **"F. The provisions of this Chapter shall not be construed to authorize the**  
21 **commission to operate as a public utility or to grant a franchise for service by a public**

31 On page 14, after line 7, insert the following:

1           "Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not  
2 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature  
3 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If  
4 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become  
5 effective on the day following such approval."
