HOUSE BILLS ON FINAL PASSAGE-R - [14 items]

1. **HB339** **BERTHELOT** **FIRE PROTECT/FIRE MARSHAL** Allows the use of public funds for length of service awards programs established by fire protection districts, municipal fire departments, or volunteer fire departments for volunteer firefighters
2. **HB360** **SHADOIN** **SHERIFFS** Provides relative to the payment of group insurance premiums for retired sheriffs and employees hired on or after September 1, 2013, for Lincoln Parish
3. **HB369** **KLECKLEY** **TAX/AD VALOREM TAX** Provides relative to information included in certain taxpayer notifications from assessors
4. **HB383** **LOPINTO** **DISTRICTS/HOSPITAL SERVC** Provides relative to the lease of a hospital by a Jefferson Parish hospital service district
5. **HB404** **MILLER** **CIVIL/JURIES** Provides for the functions of the jury commission in St. Charles Parish
6. **HB407** **ROBIDEAUX** **LEGISLATIVE POWERS** (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to prefiling and consideration of certain legislation at regular sessions
7. **HB434** **JAY MORRIS** **BUDGETARY CONTROLS** (Constitutional Amendment) Requires spending due to constitutional or other mandates to be considered in a separate appropriation bill from spending that is not required to be funded if health care or higher education funding is reduced
8. **HB435** **SEABAUGH** **BUDGETARY CONTROLS** (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to the budget process
9. **HB469** **ADAMS** **FIRE PROTECT/FIREMEN** Provides with respect to immunity from liability for volunteer firemen
10. **HB532** **KLECKLEY** **FUNDS/FUNDING** (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for a hospital stabilization formula and assessment and creates the Hospital Stabilization Fund and provides for uses of the fund
11. **HB533** **KLECKLEY** **FUNDS/FUNDING** (Constitutional Amendment) Creates the Medical Assistance Trust Fund as a constitutional fund, creates accounts for each provider paying fees into the fund, and provides for uses of the fund
12. **HB583** **COX** **EMPLOYMENT** Prohibits employers from terminating employment of a veteran for attending medical appointments necessary for veterans benefits
13. **HB705** **PONTI** **TAX CREDITS** Provides relative to solar energy systems tax credit and removes wind energy systems tax credit

14. **HB720** **ABRAMSON** **PROPERTY/PUBLIC** Provides for the authority to transfer or lease certain state property in Orleans Parish and St. Martin Parish

1. **HB437** **HARRIS** **BUDGETARY CONTROLS** Provides with respect to the development of the budget
2. **HB620** **GEYMANN** **BUDGETARY CONTROLS** Requires spending due to constitutional or other mandates to be considered in a separate appropriation bill from spending that is not required to be funded if health care or higher education funding is reduced
3. **HB629** **BROADWATER** **REVENUE DEPARTMENT** Establishes the office of debt recovery at the Dept. of Revenue for the collection of delinquent debts owed to certain governmental entities
4. **HB430** **LEGER** **SECRETARY OF STATE** Increases certain fees chargeable by the secretary of state

2. **HB44** **HAZEL** **PUBLIC RECORDS** Provides an exception to confidentiality provisions of public records law for requests made by specified entities for certain information in personnel records of certain public employees
3. **HB253** **LEOPOLD** **ELECTIONS/POLLING PLACES** Provides relative to law enforcement officers at polling places

HOUSE BILLS ON FINAL PASSAGE-R - [17 items]

1. **HB95** **DIXON** **STUDENT/SCH ATTENDANCE** Provides relative to eligibility criteria for admission or readmission to a public school and prohibits the denial of admission or readmission based on certain student characteristics
2. **HB98** **J.THOMPSON** **WEAPONS/HANDGUNS** Provides with respect to concealed handgun permits issued by sheriffs
3. **HB111** **HOFFMANN** **HEALTH/SMOKING** Prohibits outdoor smoking within 25 feet of certain exterior locations of state buildings
4. **HB173** **HAZEL** **CHILDREN** Amends Louisiana's safe haven law to provide that a child 60 days old or younger may be relinquished to a designated emergency care facility
5. **HB194** **LEGER** **STUDENT/TUITION** Provides relative to the authority of public postsecondary education management boards to increase tuition and mandatory fee amounts
6. **HB209** **GAROFALO** **LEGISLATIVE AGENCIES** Provides authority for legislative fiscal staff to access certain information from state agencies
7. **HB281** **SIMON** **HEALTH/DHH** Creates a single license for behavioral health services providers
8. **HB308** **ADAMS** **PUBLIC MEETINGS** Provides relative to public meetings of parish and municipal governing authorities
9. **HB322** **THIERRY** **CHILDREN/NEWBORNS** Requires birthing facilities to perform pulse oximetric screening for certain heart defects on each newborn in the care of those facilities
10. **HB337** **LORUSSO** **HEALTH/DHH** Provides for retail food establishment permit fees

| 15. | HB721 | MONTOUCET | TRANSPORTATION DEPT Requires DOTD to provide maps of highway priority projects by House and Senate districts to all members of the legislature |
