Provides for authorized positions in the executive budget and appropriation bills

HB 192 EDWARDS CIVIL/PROCEDURE
Provides for the continuous revision of the Code of Civil Procedure

HB 272 GREENE FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS
Provides for an application for licensure fee and licensure renewal fee for professional geoscientists and geoscientists-in-training

HB 273 LORUSSO BOARDS/COMMISSIONS
Provides relative to reports, records, and adjudicatory functions of the La. State Board of Medical Examiners

HB 298 CHANEY LEGISLATIVE POWERS
Provides relative to the membership of the La. Commission on Civic Education

HB 525 HARRIS TANF
Revises provisions relative to aid to needy families and employment services for TANF cash assistance recipients

HB 540 JONES, SAM TEACHERS
Provides relative to the eligibility of nationally certified school teachers, counselors, and psychologists for specific salary adjustments

HB 557 WILLMOTT CHILDREN/ABUSE
Requires training be made available for mandatory reporters

HB 628 BARRAS LEGISLATION
Provides for technical corrections to various provisions of the La. Revised Statutes, the Children's Code, and the Code of Criminal Procedure

HCR 73 BURNS, HENRY MINERALS/RIGHTS-ROYALTY
Requests the Louisiana Mineral Law Institute to study and make recommendations relative to timely payment of mineral royalties

HCR 74 BROSSETT LEGISLATIVE POWERS
Requires submission for approval by the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget of any cooperative endeavor agreements between the LSU Board of Supervisors and a private entity involving the change in management of a public hospital

SR 5 BROOME EDUCATION DEPARTMENT
Directs the Department of Education to study public school compliance with state law regarding required physical activity in schools.

Senate Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage

SB 2 PEACOCK MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEE RET
Provides for board membership of the Municipal Employees' Retirement System. (6/30/13)

SB 30 MORRELL COURTS
Creates a justice services commission to analyze, study, and recommend improved methods for managing and coordinating such services in Orleans Parish. (8/1/13)

SB 114 MARTINY CORONERS
Provides relative to protective custody orders in Jefferson Parish. (8/1/13)

SB 164 MARTINY VIDEO POKER
Provides relative to the Video Draw Poker Devices Control Law. (8/1/13)

SB 1 CLAITOR LEGISLATION
Constitutional amendment to prohibit legislation relative to state tax rebates from being considered during a regular session held in an even-numbered year. (2/3-CA13s1(A))

SB 15 PERRY REGISTRARS OF VOTERS
Authorizes the registrars of voters to make changes of address, changes of party affiliation or nonaffiliation and changes of name received prior to the close of the registration records for the general election. (gov sig)

SB 19 ALLAIN PROPERTY INSURANCE
Prohibits Citizens Insurance Corporation from assessing rates in excess of 25% per year without approval from the Senate and House committees on insurance. (8/1/13)

SB 23 PEACOCK MOTOR VEHICLES
Provides relative to new or relocated motorcycle or all-terrain vehicle dealerships. (8/1/13)

SB 36 HEITMEIER ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH
Prohibit smoking on the grounds of and inside the facilities or buildings utilized by the institutions managed and supervised by certain post secondary education management boards. (gov sig)

SB 53 ERDEY INSURANCE DEPARTMENT
Increases the continuing education requirements from six to twelve hours of approved instruction for title insurance producers. (8/1/13)

SB 55 JOHNS HEALTH/HOSPITALS DEPT
Provides for Medicaid transparency. (8/1/13)

SB 57 DORSEY-COLOMB DISEASE CONTROL
Creates the Louisiana Sickle Cell Commission. (8/1/13)

SB 61 MORRISH ETHICS
Provides for exceptions to the provisions of law relative to ethical standards for public servants. (8/1/13)

SB 86 MORRELL COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS
Provides relative to the Louisiana Mental Health Counselor Licensing Act. (1/1/14) (2/3 - CA7s2.1(A))

SB 90 MILLS HEALTH CARE
Provides for certain requirements which must be met by a physician who performs an abortion. (gov sig)

SB 120 WALSWORTH INSURANCE COMMISSIONER
Extends commissioner's authority to grant reinsurance credits to captive insurers. (gov sig)

SB 174 MARTINY CREDIT
Provides for the use of defenses by a debtor in an action by a creditor on a credit agreement. (gov sig)

Provides relative to banks and mutual associations. (gov sig)

SB 59 BUFFINGTON POSTSECONDARY ED
Requires the boards of supervisors for the Louisiana State University, Southern University, University of Louisiana and Louisiana Community and Technical College systems to broadcast the live audio and video of all board and committee meetings conducted in Baton Rouge on the Internet. (1/1/14)

SB 98 NEVERS MOTOR VEHICLES
Requires that over-the-counter applications for motor vehicle certificates of title be made only to a public license tag agent. (1/1/14)

SB 117 APPEL POSTSECONDARY ED
Provides for the creation of the Outcomes-Based Funding Task Force. (gov sig)

SB 118 APPEL POSTSECONDARY ED
Provides relative to the use, expenditure, or allocation of funds appropriated to public postsecondary education management boards. (gov sig)

SB 217 SMITH, GARY ROADS/HIGHWAYS
Prohibits the transport of hazardous materials on that portion of La. Hwy. 48 designated as Apple Street in Norco. (8/1/13)
