- SB 65 MURRAY PUBLIC CONTRACTS
Exempts the New Orleans Aviation Board from certain restrictions on the use of construction managers or third-party consultants. (8/1/13)
- SB 73 WHITE SCHOOLS
Constitutional amendment to grant the Southeast Baton Rouge community school system in East Baton Rouge Parish the same authority granted parishes relative to MFP funding and raising revenue for schools. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))
- SB 84 RISER WILDLIFE/FISHERIES DEPT
Authorizes a checkoff for a donation to Hunters for the Hungry when purchasing a fishing or hunting license. (gov sig)
- SB 85 JOHNS PUBLIC LANDS
Exempts the Sabine River Authority from the requirement that property acquired by the state or a political subdivision which is to be transferred to a third party must first be offered to the person from whom it was originally transferred. (gov sig)
- SB 130 APPEL EARLY CHILDHOOD ED
Creates the Early Childhood Care and Education Network and the Tiered Kindergarten Readiness Improvement System. (gov sig)
- SB 154 MURRAY PUBLIC LANDS
Authorizes a cooperative endeavor agreement for use of certain state property situated in Orleans Parish. (gov sig)
- SB 160 DORSEY-COLOMB PUBLIC WORKS
Identifies which Department of Public Works is referenced in certain groundwater conservation districts. (gov sig)
- SB 161 CHABERT PUBLIC CONTRACTS
Provides \$1,000,000 annual limit on work performed by a public entity with its own employees and resources to restore or rehabilitate certain levees and extends the termination date. (1/1/14)
- SB 170 DONAHUE PUBLIC LANDS
Authorizes and provides for the transfer of certain state property in St. Tammany Parish. (gov sig)
- SB 173 MORRELL AIRCRAFT/AVIATION
Provides for management, control, and maintenance of the New Orleans Lakefront Airport. (1/1/14)
- SB 196 DONAHUE FISCAL CONTROLS
Provides for the annual reporting to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget by departments and public postsecondary education management boards on enacted legislation with significant fiscal impact. (7/1/13)
- SB 210 MURRAY PUBLIC CONTRACTS
Authorizes a political subdivision to charge a fee, in lieu of a deposit, for production of paper documents under certain circumstances. (gov sig)
- SB 215 HEITMEIER WATER/WATERWAYS
Provides for ferries on the Mississippi River. (7/1/13)
- SB 216 WALSWORTH PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS
Authorizes the transfer of certain state property in Ouachita Parish. (8/1/13)
- SB 237 PETERSON SPECIAL DISTRICTS
Provides for legislation relative to the BioDistrict New Orleans' board general powers. (8/1/13)
- SB 240 MURRAY COURTS
Authorizes imposition of court cost in Orleans Parish Criminal District Court under certain circumstances to defray operating expenses of clerk. (2/3 - CA7s2.1) (gov sig)

- SB 36 HEITMEIER ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH
Prohibit smoking on the grounds of and inside the facilities or buildings utilized by the institutions managed and supervised by certain post secondary education management boards. (gov sig)
- SB 59 BUFFINGTON POSTSECONDARY ED
Requires the boards of supervisors for the Louisiana State University, Southern University, University of Louisiana and Louisiana Community and Technical College systems to broadcast the live audio and video of all board and committee meetings conducted in Baton Rouge on the Internet. (1/1/14)
- SB 86 MORRELL COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS
Provides relative to the Louisiana Mental Health Counselor Licensing Act. (1/1/14) (2/3 - CA7s2.1(A))
- SB 98 NEVERS MOTOR VEHICLES
Requires that over-the-counter applications for motor vehicle certificates of title be made only to a public license tag agent. (1/1/14)
