SR 53 PETERSON ADMINISTRATION DIVISION
Directs the office of community development to follow certain recommendations of the legislative auditor and the Department of Housing and Urban Development, office of inspector general.

HB 9 WILLIAMS, P COURTS/CITY
Increases the jurisdictional amount in dispute in the City Court of Shreveport

HB 18 DANAHAY DISTRICTS/INDUSTRIAL
Provides relative to meetings of the Sulphur Industrial Development District

HB 22 DANAHAY RETIREMENT/SHERIFFS FUND
Provides relative to the calculation of final average compensation in the Sheriffs' Pension and Relief Fund

HB 36 DANAHAY RETIREMENT/SHERIFFS FUND
Provides relative to the transfer of service credit into the Sheriffs' Pension and Relief Fund

HB 37 LANDRY, NANCY RETIREMENT/REGISTR VOTER
Requires promulgation of actuarial assumptions by the board of trustees for the Registrars of Voters Employees' Retirement System

HB 38 GREENE RETIREMENT/REGISTR VOTER
Provides relative to employee contributions in the Registrars of Voters Employees' Retirement System

HB 48 BURNS, HENRY WEAPONS/FIREARMS
Amends the definition of alcoholic beverage outlet for the purposes of the crime of carrying a firearm on the premises of an alcoholic beverage outlet

HB 236 LEOPOLD FISHING/OYSTERS
Increases penalties for certain oyster harvesting violations

HB 243 CARTER STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHP
Provides relative to the eligibility of certain students who graduate from certain out-of-state or out-of-country high schools to receive a Taylor Opportunity Program for Students (TOPS) award

HB 257 RITCHIE INSURANCE/PROPERTY
Adds a member to the Louisiana Citizens Property Insurance Corporation's board of directors

HB 262 ST. GERMAIN FIRE PROTECT/FIRE MARSHAL
Adds failure to register as a convicted arsonist and violations of a fire marshal's orders to the list of offenses for which a fire marshal may conduct investigations and make arrests

HB 265 IVEY WEAPONS/HANDGUNS
Provides for lifetime concealed handgun permits

HB 512 MORENO CRIMINAL/TRIALS
Provides relative to the interruption of time limitations for the commencement of a criminal trial

HB 543 PIERRE INSURANCE/SURPLUS LINE
Provides relative to regulation of surplus lines insurance

HB 612 GREENE STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHP
Permits use of TOPS awards at eligible La. institutions by otherwise qualified students who graduated from out-of-state colleges or universities

HB 719 HOWARD FISHING/RECREATIONAL
Provides relative to a possession limit for crappie taken from Toledo Bend Reservoir on a recreational fishing license

Directs the Department of Education to study public school compliance with state law regarding required physical activity in schools.

SCR 1 CORTEZ RETIREMENT SYSTEMS
Suspends Chapter 7 of Subtitle II of Title 11 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 1399.1 through 1399.7.

SB 220 WALSWORTH CHILDREN
Provides for the "Louisiana Has Faith in Families" Act. (gov sig)

SB 18 WARD PUBLIC HEALTH
Provides for cake and cookie products and preparation of cakes and cookies in home for public consumption. (8/1/13)

SB 20 ALLAIN LOCAL FINANCE
Provides certain requirements for meetings at which consideration of or action upon proposals by political subdivisions to levy, increase, renew, or continue property or sales taxes, or authorize the calling of an election for submittal of such question to voters are scheduled. (8/1/13)

SB 51 LONG CIVIL PROCEDURE
Provides relative to municipal and parish actions, liens, and proceedings for blighted or abandoned property and for violations of public health, housing and certain other ordinances. (gov sig)

SB 81 PEACOCK COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS
Provides relative to registration of certain home improvement contractors. (8/1/13)

SB 101 JOHNS LIFE INSURANCE
Provides with respect to life insurance reserves. (1/1/14)

SB 129 SMITH, JOHN ETHICS
Provides for an exception to the definition of "public employee" relative to the Code of Governmental Ethics. (8/1/13)

SB 134 MORRELL HEALTH SERVICES
Provides for licensure of behavior analysts. (8/1/13) (2/3 - CA 7s2.1(A))

SB 136 CHABERT MOTOR VEHICLES
Provides relative to motor vehicles. (8/1/13)

SB 166 CLAITOR LOANS
Provides relative to consumer litigation loans. (gov sig)

SB 171 DONAHUE SANITARY CODE
Provides for certain limitations relative to actions or rules requiring modification of certain existing community water systems. (gov sig)

SB 180 ERDEY INSURANCE DEPARTMENT
Provides relative to the division of insurance fraud in the Department of Insurance. (8/1/13)

SB 191 MORRELL ELECTION DAYS
Changes the dates for municipal and parochial elections, inaugurations, and qualifying periods, in certain parishes. (see Act)

SB 222 WALSWORTH CHILDREN
Revises licensure procedures for child day care centers and facilities. (8/1/13)

SB 16 LONG RETIREMENT SYSTEMS
Provides for the definition of "regular retirement plan" for higher education employees participating in the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana. (2/3 - CA10s29(F)) (gov sig)

SB 36 HEITMEIER ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH
Prohibit smoking on the grounds of and inside the facilities or buildings utilized by the institutions managed and supervised by certain post secondary education management boards. (gov sig)

SB 42 MORRELL SPECIAL DISTRICTS
Provides relative to the New Orleans Regional Business Park. (gov sig)

SB 50 ERDEY FUNDS/FUNDING
Establishes the Juban Crossing Economic Development District Fund as a special fund in the state treasury and provides for the disposition of certain sales tax proceeds within Livingston Parish. (7/1/13)

SB 59 BUFFINGTON POSTSECONDARY ED
Requires the boards of supervisors for the Louisiana State University, Southern University, University of Louisiana and Louisiana Community and Technical College systems to broadcast the live audio and video of all board and committee meetings conducted in Baton Rouge on the Internet. (1/1/14)

SB 73 WHITE SCHOOLS
Constitutional amendment to grant the Southeast Baton Rouge community school system in East Baton Rouge Parish the same authority granted parishes relative to MFP funding and raising revenue for schools. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))

SB 86 MORRELL COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS
Provides relative to the Louisiana Mental Health Counselor Licensing Act. (1/1/14) (2/3 - CA7s2.1(A))

SB 98 NEVERS MOTOR VEHICLES
Requires that over-the-counter applications for motor vehicle certificates of title be made only to a public license tag agent. (1/1/14)

SB 164 MARTINY VIDEO POKER
Provides relative to the Video Draw Poker Devices Control Law. (8/1/13)

SB 173 MORRELL AIRCRAFT/AVIATION
Provides for management, control, and maintenance of the New Orleans Lakefront Airport. (1/1/14)

SB 215 HEITMEIER WATER/WATERWAYS
Provides for ferries on the Mississippi River. (7/1/13)
