Senate Concurrent Resolutions Returned from House With Amendments

- SCR 78 AMEDEE CAMPAIGN FINANCE
Requests the Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs and the House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs to jointly study the appropriate use of campaign funds.
- SCR 87 HEITMEIER HEALTH/HOSPITALS DEPT
Directs the Department of Health and Hospitals to submit a Section 1115 demonstration waiver to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services that replaces upper payment limit funding and creates funding pools to replace upper payment limit payments.

Senate Bills Returned from House Subject to Call

- SB 127 SMITH, GARY EDUCATION ACCOUNTABILITY
Provides that a student with disabilities who is not pursuing a regular diploma shall not be administered the American College Test. (gov sig)
- SB 205 LAFLEUR SCHOOLS
Provides for the establishment of foreign language immersion programs in public school districts and repeals the Balanced Treatment for Creation-Science and Evolution-Science Act. (8/1/13)

Senate Concurrent Resolutions to be Adopted Subject to Call

- SCR 65 GALLOT ADMINISTRATION DIVISION
Directs the commissioner of administration to ensure that the name and contact information of each custodian of public records of an agency be included on the website of the agency.

Senate Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage Subject to Call

- SB 59 BUFFINGTON POSTSECONDARY ED
Requires the boards of supervisors for the Louisiana State University, Southern University, University of Louisiana and Louisiana Community and Technical College systems to broadcast the live audio and video of all board and committee meetings conducted in Baton Rouge on the Internet. (1/1/14)
- SB 92 WALSWORTH CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Provides responsive verdicts for the crime of aggravated incest. (gov sig)
- SB 98 NEVERS MOTOR VEHICLES
Requires that over-the-counter applications for motor vehicle certificates of title be made only to a public license tag agent. (1/1/14)
- SB 157 ALLAIN FISH/FISHING
Prohibits the take, sale, possession, or importation of red snapper. (8/1/13)
- SB 184 LONG WILDLIFE/FISHERIES DEPT
Provides that the Louisiana Seafood and Promotion and Marketing Board shall act independently from the secretary of the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries. (7/1/13)
- SB 226 ALARIO FUNDS/FUNDING
To provide relative to special funds in the state treasury. (gov sig)
- SB 246 NEVERS FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides for the dedication of revenues realized from the expansion of health insurance coverage pursuant to the Affordable Care Act. (8/1/13)

Requests certain officials and entities responsible for incarcerated inmates to make recommendations to allow certain incarcerated persons to vote

House Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage

HB 103 BADON CRIMINAL/SENTENCING
Reduces criminal penalties for possession of marijuana and prohibits the applicability of the Habitual Offender Law relative to possession of marijuana

House Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage Subject to Call

HB 5 MORRIS, JIM WEAPONS/FIREARMS
Prohibits the enforcement of federal restrictions regarding the ownership or possession of semi-automatic firearms

HB 121 MONTOUCET WORKERS COMPENSATION
Provides with respect to the membership of the Workers' Compensation Advisory Council

HB 193 GISCLAIR TAX CREDITS
Provides relative to certain port and harbor activities for purposes of qualifying for the ports of La. tax credit

HB 198 MORRIS, JAY INSURANCE
Extends commissioner's authority to grant reinsurance credits to captive insurers

HB 238 WILLIAMS, P TAX
Provides relative to the telecommunications tax for the deaf

HB 293 FOIL EVIDENCE
Allows certain certified records to be used as evidence

HB 395 GUINN MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC
Provides for the inclusion of certain medical information on drivers' licenses and special identification cards

HB 420 PIERRE FUNDS/FUNDING
Redistributes a portion of the monies in the Lafayette Parish Visitor Enterprise Fund

HB 470 WILLMOTT ANIMALS
Prohibits the transportation of dogs in pickup truck beds and utility trailers on certain roadways unless safely crated

HB 501 MORENO TAX CREDITS
Extends the sunset of the musical and theatrical production base investment income tax credit

HB 544 PONTI MORTGAGES
Allows the commissioner of OFI to promulgate rules to allow for a licensing exemption for certain mortgage loan originators

Instruments Pending Senate Conference

SB 1 CLAITOR LEGISLATION
Constitutional amendment to prohibit legislation relative to state tax rebates from being considered during a regular session held in an even-numbered year. (2/3-CA13s1(A))

SB 37 SMITH, GARY TAX/TAXATION
Authorizes for corporations a net operating loss carryback of 5 years if the loss is attributable to Hurricane Isaac. (see Act)

SB 47 MORRELL LOCAL AGENCIES
Provides relative to the Sewerage and Water Board of the city of New Orleans. (See Act)

SB 185 MURRAY HEALTH CARE
Provides relative to Medicaid and certain managed health care organizations providing health care services to Medicaid beneficiaries. (gov sig)

SB 218 MORRELL ROADS/HIGHWAYS
Prohibits DOTD from collecting fines from persons not paying tolls on the Crescent City Connection. (gov sig)

HB 1 FANNIN APPROPRIATIONS
Provides for the ordinary operating expenses of state government for Fiscal Year 2013-2014

HB	620	GEYMANN	BUDGETARY CONTROLS	Requires spending due to constitutional or other mandates to be considered in a separate appropriation bill from spending that is not required to be funded if health care or higher education funding is reduced
HB	629	BROADWATER	REVENUE DEPARTMENT	Establishes the office of debt recovery at the Dept. of Revenue for the collection of delinquent debts owed to certain governmental entities
HB	664	LANDRY, TERRY	AGRICULTURE/SWEET POTATO	Provides relative to the sweet potato industry
HB	720	ABRAMSON	PROPERTY/PUBLIC	Provides for the authority to transfer or lease certain state property in Orleans Parish and St. Martin Parish
