Senate Bills on Second Reading to be Referred

- SB 275 MARTINY FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides for the dedication of certain monies to the Hospital Revenue Equalization Fund which is created in the state treasury for the purpose of providing uncompensated care to public, nonstate, nonrural hospitals. (gov sig)
- SB 276 MARTINY TAX/SALES
Phases out state sales tax over a six-year period on transactions related to certain tangible personal property used or consumed by a communications service provider in providing communications services or which is integral or necessary for the installation, operation, or maintenance of such property. (7/1/15)
- SB 277 CROWE TAX/TAXATION
Limits claims for credit against individual income tax, corporate income tax, or corporate franchise tax on tax returns filed for a calendar year to 15% of the general fund revenues for the fiscal year. (7/1/15)

- SB 55 RISER AGRICULTURE/FOREST DEPT
Provides relative to the Louisiana Forestry Commission and tree seedling nurseries. (gov sig)
- SB 59 WARD INSURERS
Provides relative to the withdrawal of deposits by domestic insurers. (gov sig)
- SB 64 MARTINY BANKS/BANKING
Provides relative to the sale and purchase of excess reserves by banks. (8/1/15)
- SB 79 ALLAIN MINERALS
Provides for alternative dispute resolution for disputes relating to remediation of oilfield sites and exploration and production sites. (8/1/15)
- SB 83 WHITE COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS
Provides relative to exceptions from the issuance of provisional licenses to ex-offenders in order to work in certain fields. (8/1/15)
- SB 154 SMITH, G. INSURANCE COMMISSIONER
Provide for the authority of the commissioner of insurance to require fingerprints of applicants for licenses and certificates of authority. (gov sig)
- SB 178 AMEDEE AGRICULTURE/FOREST DEPT
Provides relative to meat and poultry inspection. (gov sig)
- SB 182 THOMPSON, FRANCIS TELECOMMUNICATIONS
Enacts the Kelsey Smith Act to require certain communication carriers to provide cell phone location information to first responder officials in certain circumstances. (gov sig)
- SB 183 THOMPSON, FRANCIS AIRCRAFT/AVIATION
Provides for the regulation of unmanned aerial systems in agricultural commercial operations. (gov sig)
- SB 208 RISER CORONERS
Provides for disposition of remains. (7/1/15)
- SB 242 MORRELL SEX OFFENSES
Requires criminal justice agencies to annually report certain information concerning sexual assault kits and sexually-oriented criminal offenses. (gov sig)
- SB 263 THOMPSON, FRANCIS COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS
Provides relative to agriculture, forestry, and industrial equipment and certain dealer agreements. (8/1/15)

Extends the Pretrial Service Commission deadline until March 1, 2017.

- SCR 14 MORRISH CHILDREN
Continues and provides for the Task Force on the Prevention of Sexual Abuse of Children until 2017.
- SCR 29 MORRELL CRIMINAL JUSTICE
Extends the Capital Punishment Fiscal Impact Commission study and reporting deadline until January 1, 2018.

| SB | 7 | GUILLORY, E. | ROADS/HIGHWAYS | Designates the intersection of LA Hwy 182 and LA Hwy 358 in Opelousas as the "St. Landry Parish Memorial Intersection" and designates the US 190 bridge in Krotz Springs as the "Sal and Frank Diesi Bridge". (8/1/15) |
| SB | 13 | PEACOCK | FIREFIGHTERS RETIREMENT | Provides benefits for members hired on or after January 1, 2016. (6/30/15) |
