- SB 30 KOSTELKA CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Provides relative to the crime of illegal possession of stolen property. (gov sig)
- SB 36 AMEDEE SEX OFFENSES
Provides relative to sexual assault protective orders. (8/1/15)
- SB 60 KOSTELKA FRAUD
Provides relative to Medicaid fraud. (gov sig)
- SB 62 WARD CLERKS OF COURT
Authorizes the clerk of district court for East Feliciana and West Feliciana Parishes to charge an additional fee for issuing birth and death certificates. (8/1/15)
- SB 117 SMITH, G. SEX OFFENSES
Provides relative to certain sex offenses. (8/1/15)
- SB 134 PEACOCK FAMILY LAW
Provides for parental authority of married persons, obligations of children, parents, and other ascendants, and provisional custody by mandate. (1/1/16)
- SB 174 BROOME DOMESTIC VIOLENCE
Provides certain accommodations upon reasonable documentation presented by domestic abuse victims who lease residential dwellings. (8/1/15)
- SB 237 MURRAY COURTS
Provides relative to the jurisdictional limitation of certain city courts and to the constable of the first city court of New Orleans and his deputies. (gov sig)
- SB 245 ERDEY CHILDREN
Provides for the reasonable and prudent parent standard and for certain considerations in foster care case plans and licensing requirements. (gov sig)
- SB 264 DORSEY-COLOMB CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Increases penalties for the illegal use of a tracking device. (gov sig)

- SB 48 DONAHUE TOPS
Provides relative to the minimum ACT score for TOPS eligibility and TOPS award amounts. (gov sig)
- SB 88 ADLEY CONSERVATION
Provides for drilling units and authorizes the permitting of cross-unit wells. (8/1/15)
- SB 151 CORTEZ PUBLIC CONTRACTS
Provides for payments, filing of sworn statements of amount due, and cancellation of statements of claim or privilege on DOTD contracts. (gov sig)
- SB 159 HEITMEIER PUBLIC CONTRACTS
Authorizes design-build contracts for new ferries on the Mississippi River and bridges that replace tunnels. (gov sig)
- SB 162 SMITH, G. PUBLIC CONTRACTS
Authorizes construction management at risk pilot program. (8/1/15)
- SB 177 ADLEY TAX/AD VALOREM
Constitutional amendment to add certain property tax exemptions and reductions and to provide with respect to tax credits associated with them; to dedicate the net state revenue increase to a Tax Credit Reduction Fund and provide for allocations from the fund; and to provide for appropriations to local tax authorities. (2/3-CA 13sl(A))
- SB 210 RISER WILDLIFE/FISHERIES DEPT
Provides for the administration and uses of monies in the Hunters for the Hungry Account. (8/1/15)
- SB 212 WARD HUNTERS/HUNTING
Repeals provision allowing the carrying of certain firearms while hunting with a bow. (gov sig)
- SB 217 GALLOT PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS
Authorizes the transfer of certain state property in Rapides Parish. (8/1/15)
