- SB 134 PEACOCK FAMILY LAW  
Provides for parental authority of married persons, obligations of children, parents, and other ascendants, and provisional custody by mandate. (1/1/16)
- SB 174 BROOME DOMESTIC VIOLENCE  
Provides certain accommodations upon reasonable documentation presented by domestic abuse victims who lease residential dwellings. (8/1/15)
- SB 237 MURRAY COURTS  
Provides relative to the jurisdictional limitation of certain city courts and to the constable of the first city court of New Orleans and his deputies. (gov sig)
- SB 245 ERDEY CHILDREN  
Provides for the reasonable and prudent parent standard and for certain considerations in foster care case plans and licensing requirements. (gov sig)
- SB 264 DORSEY-COLOMB CRIME/PUNISHMENT  
Increases penalties for the illegal use of a tracking device. (gov sig)
- SB 86 PERRY ETHICS  
Provides relative to nepotism relating to school employees. (8/1/15)
- SB 87 PERRY ETHICS  
Removes financial disclosure requirements for members of boards and commissions that do not earn compensation or per diem. (8/1/15)
- SB 115 MILLS HEALTH CARE  
Provides with respect to the practice of physician assistants. (gov sig)
- SB 143 MILLS PHARMACISTS  
Provides relative to prescribed marijuana for therapeutic uses and the development of rules and regulations by the Louisiana Board of Pharmacy and the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners. (gov sig)
- SB 144 DORSEY-COLOMB INSURANCE PREMIUMS  
Requires insurance premium finance companies to cooperate with the Department of Insurance when insurance premiums are paid by an insurance premium finance company. (8/1/15)
- SB 152 LONG CONTRACTORS  
Moves the regulation of home service contract providers from the Department of Insurance to the secretary of state. (8/1/15)
- SB 156 MARTINY ENGINEERS  
Provides for the qualifications of professional engineers. (8/1/15)
- SB 158 HEITMEIER MALPRACTICE  
Requires the reporting of malpractice claims paid by insurers or self-insurers on behalf of certain health care providers in an annual report to the Senate and House committees on health and welfare. (gov sig)
- SB 172 MORRISH LIABILITY INSURANCE  
Provide with respect to the Transportation Network Company Motor Vehicle Responsibility Law. (gov sig)
- SB 190 CLAITOR PUBLIC RECORDS  
Provides relative to the records of the governor. (1/11/16)
- SB 216 MORRISH INSURANCE DEPARTMENT  
Provides for the reorganization of the Louisiana Department of Insurance. (gov sig)
- SB 243 SMITH, J. WARRANTIES  
Provides relative to warranty repairs of motor vehicles. (8/1/15)
- SB 273 PERRY LIBRARIES  
Repeals requirement that the one additional Vermilion Parish Library Board of Control member be subject to Senate confirmation. (8/1/15)

- SB 66 SMITH, G. PUBLIC CONTRACTS  
Extends time for ports to use the design-build method on certain construction projects. (8/1/15)
- SB 151 CORTEZ PUBLIC CONTRACTS  
Provides for payments, filing of sworn statements of amount due, and cancellation of statements of claim or privilege on DOTD contracts. (gov sig)
- SB 162 SMITH, G. PUBLIC CONTRACTS  
Authorizes construction management at risk pilot program. (8/1/15)
- SB 177 ADLEY TAX/AD VALOREM  
Constitutional amendment to add certain property tax exemptions and reductions and to provide with respect to tax credits associated with them; to dedicate the net state revenue increase to a Tax Credit Reduction Fund and provide for allocations from the fund; and to provide for appropriations to local tax authorities. (2/3-CA 13sl(A))
- SB 217 GALLOT PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS  
Authorizes the transfer of certain state property in Rapides Parish. (8/1/15)
- SB 240 LAFLEUR PUBLIC LANDS  
Provides for the exchange of school lands by the Avoyelles Parish School Board. (gov sig)
