(gov sig)
- SB 30 WARD PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS  
Adds Pointe Coupee Parish to the territorial limits and jurisdiction of the Greater Baton Rouge Port Commission. (2/3 - CA6s43(2)) (1/1/20)
- SB 76 TARVER MOTOR VEHICLES  
Provides relative to child safety seats. (8/1/19)
