Senate Resolutions 2nd Reading

- SR 57 JACKSON ANIMALS
Requests local governing authorities and animal shelters to adopt policies and programs to provide alternatives to euthanizing healthy dogs and cats.
- SR 58 JACKSON BEHAVIORAL HEALTH
Creates a task force to study the implementation of a partnership between law enforcement agencies and behavioral health providers.
- SR 59 JACKSON VOTERS/VOTING
Creates a study group to study the voting rights of persons incarcerated prior to trial.
- SR 60 JACKSON INSURANCE DEPARTMENT
Requests the Department of Insurance to create a task force to study the causes of infertility in women and mandating insurance coverage of fertility treatments for women.
- SR 61 JACKSON LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS
Reestablishes a task force to study the implementation of a partnership between law enforcement agencies and safety net hospitals in order to reduce or eliminate incidents of law enforcement officers handling nonviolent calls or behavioral or social crises where no crime has been committed.

Provides for the Fairness in Womens Sports Act relative to a school's ability to offer equal opportunities to each student to participate in team sporting events on an equal basis. (8/1/22)

Provides relative to the capital outlay process. (gov sig)
- SB 101 CATHEY COURTS
Provides relative to the traffic violations bureau in certain city courts. (gov sig)

Requires insurers provide coverage for the temporary use of a motor vehicle not owned by the insured. (8/1/22)

Establishes the Hurricane Mediation Program. (1/1/23)
- SB 218 JACKSON PUBLIC RECORDS
Adds a public records exception for certain raw data. (gov sig)
- SB 219 JACKSON COURTS
Authorizes judicial district indigent defender funds to be used for the purposes of retaining expert witnesses. (8/1/22)
- SB 225 HEWITT LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS
Constitutional Amendment to provide for remote operations of the legislature during a declared emergency. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))
