- SR 99 TALBOT INSURANCE COMMISSIONER
Urges the Commissioner of Insurance to study the issue of notice of cancellation or nonrenewal of a property insurance policy that provides coverage for property damaged by a named storm or windstorm.
- SR 103 BERNARD SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH
Designates the week of May 9-15, 2022, as Police Week in the state of Louisiana and to commend the service of law enforcement officers.

Constitutional amendment to allow adult prosecution and enhanced penalties against juveniles in correctional facilities who commit assault or battery against an employee or juvenile. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))

SB 246 ALLAIN TAX/AD VALOREM
Constitutional amendment to authorize parishes to exempt inventory from ad valorem taxation. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))

SB 247 ALLAIN TAX/AD VALOREM
Provides for procedures for parishes to exempt inventory from ad valorem taxation. (See Act)

SB 276 TALBOT HEALTH/ACC INSURANCE
Provides the original intent of the Louisiana Legislature authorized contracts between health insurers and healthcare providers allowed for benefits to be available to its affiliates. (gov sig)

SB 304 CATHEY CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Provides relative to commutation of a prison sentence for good behavior. (gov sig)
