1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, at the beginning of the line after "To" delete the remainder of the line

12 AMENDMENT NO. 6

13 On page 1, delete lines 12 through 17 and delete pages 2 through 8 and insert the following:

14 **"A. A trade association may bring an action or intervene in an action in**
15 **its own name or on behalf of one or more of its members as provided in**
16 **Subsection B of this Section, provided it meets all of the following conditions:**

17 **(1) It is primarily comprised of and controlled by a minimum of one**
18 **hundred licensed motor vehicle dealers.**

19 **(2) A minimum of one of its members holds a valid license under this**
20 **Chapter and has standing to sue or intervene individually.**

21 **(3) The interests the association seeks to protect are germane to its**
22 **purpose.**

23 **(4) Neither the claim asserted nor the relief requested requires the**
24 **participation of individual members.**

25 **B. A trade association prevailing under this Section may be granted any**
26 **of the following remedies:**

27 **(1) Declaratory relief.**

28 **(2) Injunctive relief.**

29 **(3) Reasonable costs and attorney fees.**

30 **C. An action by a trade association under this Section may be brought**
31 **before the commission or in any district court of competent jurisdiction."**
