PUBLIC CONTRACT/BIDS: Provides relative to contract limits for certain public contracts

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 38:2212(A)(1), relative to the contract limit for public works
3	contracts let by certain municipalities; to authorize certain municipalities to let
4	contracts for public works in accordance with state public bid law rather than a home
5	rule charter; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. $38:2212(A)(1)$ is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§2212. Advertisement and letting to lowest responsible and responsive bidder;
9	public work; electronic bidding; participation in mentor-protégé program;
10	exemptions
11	A.(1)(a) All public work exceeding the contract limit as defined in this
12	Section, including labor and materials, to be done by a public entity shall be
13	advertised and let by contract to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder who
14	had bid according to the bidding documents as advertised, and no such public work
15	shall be done except as provided in this Part.
16	(b) Notwithstanding any provision of a home rule charter established
17	subsequent to 1974 to the contrary, no municipality shall be required to advertise and
18	let by contract to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder, who bid according
19	to the bidding documents as advertised, any public work which is less than the
20	contract limit established by this Section. This Subparagraph shall apply only to

Abstract: Allows certain municipalities to utilize contract limits for public works set in state law rather than contract limits set in their home rule charters.

<u>Present law</u> requires all public work exceeding the contract limit as defined in <u>present law</u>, including labor and materials, to be done by a public entity to be advertised and let by contract to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder who had bid according to the bidding documents as advertised.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that, notwithstanding any provision of a home rule charter established subsequent to 1974 to the contrary, no municipality shall be required to advertise and let by contract to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder, who had bid according to the bidding documents as advertised, any public work which is less than the contract limit established by <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> would only apply to municipalities with a population of not less than 45,000 persons and not more than 50,000 persons as of the most recent federal decennial census.
