2 On page 1, line 2, change "Parish" to "parish"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 24 On page 1, delete lines 3 and 4 in their entirety and insert "to authorize the investigation of
5 traffic accidents by certain entities or officers in the parish of Orleans; to provide for
6 exceptions; to provide for qualifications and training; and to provide for related matters."7 AMENDMENT NO. 38 On page 1, line 10, change "N." to "N.(1)" and change "Parish" to "parish"9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 1, delete lines 11 and 12 in their entirety and insert the following:

11 "the superintendent of police in the city of New Orleans may authorize a
12 civilian traffic control officer or entity to investigate traffic accidents in
13 accordance with the provisions of this Subsection, with the exception of the

22 On page 1, after line 17, add the following:

23 "(2) The superintendent of police in the city of New Orleans shall
24 adopt qualifications for a civilian traffic control officer or entity to conduct
25 investigations pursuant to the provisions of this Subsection, and the civilian
26 traffic control officers or entity shall have the qualifications adopted by the
27 governing authority and shall be trained by the New Orleans Police
28 Department prior to conducting an investigation pursuant to the provisions
29 of this Subsection.30 (3) A civilian traffic control officer or entity authorized to investigate
31 traffic accidents pursuant to the provisions of this Subsection shall provide
32 an investigation report in accordance with the provisions of this Section, but
33 shall not be authorized to issue traffic citations. If the civilian traffic control
34 officer or entity has reason to believe that a criminal offense has occurred or
35 that the traffic accident involves one of the criteria listed in Paragraph (1) of

1 this Subsection, the officer or entity shall report that information immediately
2 to the New Orleans Police Department."
