(KEYWORD, SUMMARY, AND DIGEST as amended by Senate committee amendments)

CONTRACTS: Provides for reporting, review, and approval by the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget of certain professional, personal, and consulting service contracts

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#### **DIGEST**

<u>Present law</u> for FY 2015-2016 through FY 2017-2018, establishes a process that all contracts for professional, personal, and consulting services totaling \$40,000 or more per year which are funded solely with the state general fund (direct) or the Overcollections Fund and are for discretionary purposes are reported, reviewed, and approved by the JLCB.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds social services contracts totaling \$40,000 per year to the types of contracts to be reported and reviewed by JLCB.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes requirement that JLCB approve the contracts being reported and reviewed.

<u>Proposed law</u> further removes provisions regarding the funding sources for contracts to be reported and reviewed by JLCB.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

## The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Add social services contracts to the types of contracts to be reported, reviewed, and approved by the JLCB.

# Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Finance to the reengrossed bill

- 1. Changes contracts to be reviewed <u>from</u> those totaling \$25,000 or more per year <u>to</u> those totaling \$40,000 or more per year.
- 2. Removes requirement that the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget approve the contracts being reported and reviewed.
