SEWERAGE: Provides for a temporary waiver for individual sewerage systems in parishes of a certain size

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Authorizes a sewerage district located wholly within a parish with a population between 120,000 and 160,000 to merge with another sewerage district wholly within the same parish.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the Dept. of Health and Hospitals, office of public health, to temporarily waive applicable requirements of the state sanitary code regarding individual sewerage systems during the construction of a community sewerage system for properties located within the boundaries of any parish with a population between 6,800 and 6,900 according to the latest federal decennial census.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the temporary waiver to be granted only if certain conditions are met.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the parish or any municipality within the parish to provide appropriate enforcement mechanisms to discourage citizens owning property within the boundaries of the parish from doing certain actions.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes a sewerage district located wholly within a parish with a population between 120,000 and 160,000 to merge with another sewerage district wholly within the same parish.
