

1 WHEREAS, it is essential for the department to obtain input and support from the
2 legislature and the public as it develops the strategies necessary to promote a transformation
3 of the Medicaid program.

4 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
5 authorize and request the Department of Health and Hospitals to create a Medicaid
6 transformation plan which outlines strategies for operating a more efficient and effective
7 Medicaid system.

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the department shall convene a task force to
9 make recommendations to the secretary of the department concerning development of the
10 Medicaid transformation plan.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall be composed of an appointee
12 from each of the following organizations:

13 (1) The Louisiana House of Representatives appointed by the speaker of the
14 House of Representatives.

15 (2) The Louisiana Senate appointed by the president of the Senate.

16 (3) The Department of Health and Hospitals appointed by the secretary of
17 the department.

18 (4) The Department of Insurance appointed by the commissioner of
19 insurance.

20 (5) The Louisiana Association of Health Plans appointed by the chief
21 executive officer of the association.

22 (6) The Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center at New Orleans
23 appointed by the chancellor of the center.

24 (7) The Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center at Shreveport
25 appointed by the chancellor of the center.

26 (8) The Louisiana State Medical Society appointed by the chief executive
27 officer of the organization.

28 (9) The Louisiana Primary Care Association appointed by the executive
29 director of the association.

1 (10) The Rural Hospital Coalition appointed by the executive director of the
2 coalition.

3 (11) The Louisiana Pharmacists Association appointed by the executive
4 director of the association.

5 (12) The Louisiana Hospital Association appointed by the president of the
6 association.

7 (13) The Louisiana Dental Association, who shall be appointed by the
8 president of the board of directors of the association.

9 (14) The Louisiana Ambulance Alliance appointed by the president of the
10 organization.

11 (15) One representative of Medicaid enrollees of this state appointed by the
12 executive director of the Louisiana Primary Care Association.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of the task force shall serve
14 without compensation.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall recommend to the secretary
16 Medicaid transformation strategies which achieve all of the following objectives:

17 (1) Reflect Louisiana values.

18 (2) Make efficient use of taxpayer dollars.

19 (3) Promote personal responsibility.

20 (4) Assure access to quality care.

21 (5) Improve population health outcomes with evidence-based approaches.

22 (6) Provide for adequate and equitable reimbursement for healthcare services.

23 (7) Maximize federal funding.

24 (8) Protect graduate medical education.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that legislative authority for the task force shall
26 terminate on March 1, 2017.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the department shall submit the Medicaid
28 transformation plan required by this Resolution in the form of a written report to the
29 legislature on or before March 1, 2017.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the report shall include specific
2 recommendations for enhancing the ability of Medicaid enrollees to use health services
3 efficiently and responsibly, and for better quality of care through incentives which reward
4 value rather than volume.

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that innovations in the Medicaid program to be
6 addressed in the plan may include but shall not be limited to the feasibility of implementing
7 a Section 1115 demonstration waiver program, cost sharing functions inclusive of
8 copayments and coinsurance, health savings accounts, and any other mechanism permitted
9 by federal law.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
11 secretary of the Department of Health and Hospitals, the commissioner of insurance, the
12 chief executive officer of the Louisiana Association of Health Plans, the chancellor of the
13 Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center at New Orleans, the chancellor of the
14 Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center at Shreveport, the chief executive officer
15 of the Louisiana State Medical Society, the executive director of the Louisiana Primary Care
16 Association, the executive director of the Rural Hospital Coalition, the executive director
17 of the Louisiana Pharmacists Association, the president of the Louisiana Hospital
18 Association, the president of the board of directors of the Louisiana Dental Association, and
19 the president of the Louisiana Ambulance Alliance.

1. Add the La. Dental Assoc. and La. Ambulance Alliance to the list of organizations from which members of the task force are appointed.
2. Specify the person who appoints the member to the task force from each organization.
3. Make technical changes.

The House Floor Amendments to the reengrossed Resolution:

1. Add a representative of La. Medicaid enrollees appointed by the executive director of the La. Primary Care Association as a member of the task force.
