#### Abstract

AN ACT To enact R.S. 44:4(51) and (52), relative to public records; to provide for the application of the public records law; to provide exceptions from the public records law for certain records of the State Licensing Board for Contractors; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: Section 1. R.S. $44: 4(51)$ and (52) are hereby enacted to read as follows: §4. Applicability This Chapter shall not apply: (51) To any records, writings, accounts, recordings, letters, exhibits, pictures, drawings, charts, photographs, memoranda, reports, examinations, or evaluations, or copies thereof, in the custody of the State Licensing Board for Contractors concerning the fitness of any person to receive or continue to hold a license issued by the board. However, any such record may be released to the public in an administrative proceeding before the board, and any final determination made by the board relative to the fitness of any person to receive or to continue to hold a license issued by the board and any legal grounds upon which such determination is based shall be a public record. (52) To any portion of an examination administered or to be administered by the State Licensing Board for Contractors, or to any answers

for such an examination administered or to be administered by the board.
However, any person who has taken an examination administered by the board may inspect his examination.
