2	To enact Part VII of Chapter 9 of Title 23 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, to be
3	comprised of R.S. 23:1001, relative to employment of veterans; to provide for
4	legislative intent; to authorize certain private employers to provide preferences in
5	employment for certain veterans; to provide for policy; and to provide for related
6	matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. Part VII of Chapter 9 of Title 23 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of
9	1950, comprised of R.S. 23:1001, is hereby enacted to read as follows:
10	PART VII. EMPLOYMENT OF VETERANS
11	§1001. Preference in hiring veterans for private employers
12	A.(1) The intent of the legislature is to authorize private employers to
13	establish a preference in employment for certain veterans which shall be
14	analogous to the system by which the state and city governments give
15	preferences in employment to veterans pursuant to Article X, Section 10 of the
16	Constitution of Louisiana.
17	(2) It is the intent of the legislature that the provisions of this Section are
18	permissive and not mandatory as it relates to private employers.
19	B. A private employer may adopt an employment policy that gives
20	preference in hiring to all of the following:
21	(1) An honorably discharged veteran.
22	(2) The spouse of a veteran with a service-connected disability.
23	(3) The unremarried widow or widower of a veteran who died of a
24	service-connected disability.

1 (4) The unremarried widow or widower of a member of the United States 2 Armed Forces who died in the line of duty under combat-related conditions. 3 C. An employer may voluntarily establish a policy which grants 4 preference in hiring to a veteran or a certain family member of a veteran 5 pursuant to the provisions of this Part. 6 D. The preferences for the employment of veterans provided for in this 7 Part shall not be considered a violation of any state or local equal employment 8 opportunity law.
