18	(5)(a) A person who is no longer enrolled in a public
19	school but was identified as a student with an exceptionality as
20	defined in R.S. 17:1942(B), except a gifted or talented student,
21	and who previously failed to receive a high school diploma or was
22	denied graduation solely for failing to meet the exit examination
23	requirements pursuant to State Board of Elementary and
24	Secondary Education rules, regulations, or policy may petition
25	the city, parish, or other local public school board to determine
26	if he is eligible to receive a high school diploma pursuant to this
27	Paragraph. A petition shall be submitted to the local school
28	board by December 31, 2017.
29	(b) The local school board shall transmit diploma requests
30	to the state Department of Education in accordance with
31	department procedures and guidelines. A person receiving a
32	diploma pursuant to this Paragraph shall not be counted as a
33	graduate in any graduation rate calculations for affected schools
34	and districts, including calculations for any prior year.
35	(c) Not later than January 31, 2018, the state Department
36	of Education shall report in writing to the State Board of
37	Elementary and Secondary Education, the House Committee on

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Education, and the Senate Committee on Education the number

1	of diplomas granted, by school district, pursuant to this
2	Paragraph.
3	(d) The State Board of Elementary and Secondary
4	Education shall promulgate rules in accordance with the
5	Administrative Procedure Act for the implementation of this
6	Paragraph. The state Department of Education shall disseminate
7	a copy of the requirements of this Paragraph and procedures and
8	guidelines for submitting petitions to each city, parish, and other
9	local public school system not later than ninety days after the
10	effective date of this Paragraph. Such procedures and guidelines
11	shall include but shall not be limited to the following:
12	(i) The eligibility criteria for submitting a petition.
13	(ii) The petition process, including but not limited to the
14	deadline for submitting a petition and all other applicable
15	deadlines.
16	(iii) A contact name and phone number at the state
17	Department of Education available to persons submitting
18	petitions.
