8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 11:2072(A) and (B)(1) are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
10	11:2072(C) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
11	§2072. Annual amount of retirement allowance
12	A. The annual amount of the retirement allowance for persons who retired
13	from this system on or before June 30, 1999, shall be three percent of the average
14	final compensation for each year of creditable service.
15	B.(1) The annual amount of the retirement allowance for any person who is
16	an active contributing member of this system on and or after July 1, 1999, and whose
17	first employment making him eligible for membership in the system began prior to
18	occurred on or before January 1, 2013, and for any person who first becomes a
19	member of this system on and after July 1, 1999, but before January 1, 2013, shall
20	be equal to three and one-third percent of the average final compensation for each
21	year of creditable service.

# 1C. The retirement allowance provided to a member pursuant to the2provisions of this Section shall not exceed one hundred percent of the member's3average compensation.4Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not5signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature6by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If

- 7 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
- 8 effective on the day following such approval.
