A RESOLUTION

2	To foster awareness about Alzheimer's disease and to recognize the month of June 2016 as
3	"Go Purple Month".
4	WHEREAS, the national Alzheimer's Association has declared June 2016 to be
5	Alzheimer's & Brain Awareness Month; and
6	WHEREAS, Alzheimer's disease is the sixth leading cause of death in the United
7	States; more people die of Alzheimer's disease than breast and prostate cancer patients
8	combined; and
9	WHEREAS, the Alzheimer's Association recognizes that everyone who has a brain
10	is at risk of developing Alzheimer's, a progressive brain disease that has no cure and is not
11	a normal part of the aging process; fewer than fifty percent of people with Alzheimer's
12	disease report being told of their diagnosis; and
13	WHEREAS, more than fifteen million Americans provide unpaid care for individuals
14	with Alzheimer's or some other form of dementia; healthcare costs for patients with
15	Alzheimer's and other dementias could reach two hundred thirty-six billion dollars nationally
16	in 2016; and
17	WHEREAS, in Louisiana, the Alzheimer's Association has estimated that there are
18	as many as eighty-four thousand citizens aged sixty-five and older who suffer from the
19	disease; and
20	WHEREAS, the symptoms of Alzheimer's include difficulty remembering newly
21	learned information; disorientation; mood and behavioral changes; deepening confusion

1 about events, times, and places; unfounded suspicions about family, friends, and caregivers; 2 and difficulty speaking, swallowing, and walking; and 3 WHEREAS, the color purple was selected to symbolize support for those who work 4 with patients diagnosed with Alzheimer's and family and friends who are caregivers of 5 Alzheimer's patients; and 6 WHEREAS, research is ongoing to uncover critical information for the diagnosis and treatment of Alzheimer's and related dementias, and during the month of June, Louisiana 7 8 citizens are encouraged to wear purple and take action to raise awareness of this deadly 9 disease. 10 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
