AN ACT

2	To enact R.S. 33:9682, relative to political subdivisions; to authorize a political subdivision
3	to open proceedings with a voluntary prayer; to provide certain terms and conditions;
4	and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 33:9682 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§9682. Political subdivisions; voluntary prayer
8	A. A political subdivision may open proceedings with a voluntary prayer.
9	However, no official or standard prayer shall be prescribed by the political
10	subdivision.
11	B. This Section is intended to reflect the tradition and practice of
12	ceremonial invocations that are meant to lend gravity to a public occasion.
13	C. Nothing in this Section shall be construed to limit or restrict the
14	rights of any individual who voluntarily chooses to pray at the opening of
15	proceedings as it relates to the individual's right of freedom of speech or right
16	of the free exercise of religion as guaranteed pursuant to the First Amendment
	of the Constitution of the United States.
