<u>New law</u> provides that it is unlawful for someone to intentionally claim more than one homestead exemption.

<u>New law</u> provides criminal penalties which require imprisonment for up to six months, a fine not to exceed \$500, or both.

<u>New law</u> provides that a person convicted of <u>new law</u> shall be ordered to make full restitution to the state or governmental subdivision who has suffered a financial loss as a result of the offense. If a person ordered to make restitution is found to be indigent and therefore unable to make restitution in full at the time of conviction, the court shall order a periodic payment plan consistent with the person's financial ability.
