Existing law provides for the care of students with diabetes enrolled in public and nonpublic elementary and secondary schools. Requires that a diabetes management and treatment plan be submitted by each student with diabetes who seeks care for his diabetes while at school or while participating in a school-related activity. Provides that the school nurse or an unlicensed diabetes care assistant shall provide care to a student with diabetes or assist a student with treating and managing his own diabetes.

<u>Existing law</u> defines unlicensed diabetes care assistant as a school employee who volunteers to be trained in accordance with <u>existing law</u>. <u>New law</u> provides that the term also means an employee of an entity that contracts with the school or school system to provide school nurses.
