5	Parish Sheriff to name a certain building after a living person; and to provide for
6	related matters.

0	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
1	Section 1. R.S. 33:4712.17 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
12	§4712.17. Naming of St. John the Baptist Sheriff's Office law enforcement training
13	<u>facility</u>
4	Notwithstanding R.S. 42:267 or any other law to the contrary, the St. John
15	the Baptist Parish Sheriff may name the sheriff's office law enforcement training
16	facility located on Cambridge Drive in LaPlace in honor of Lloyd B. Johnson, a
17	living person who served as sheriff of St. John the Baptist Parish for more than
18	twenty years.
