<u>Proposed law</u> creates the Louisiana Human Trafficking Prevention Commission and Advisory Board in the office of the governor.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the duties of the commission and authorizes it to request data from state departments and agencies.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the commission to report annually to the governor and the legislature.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the membership of the commission, the appointment of a chairperson and secretary, and the term of the appointments.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the appointment of a proxy.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that legislative members shall receive per diem and reimbursement for travel expenses and nonlegislative members shall serve without compensation.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the commission to hold its first meeting by August 1, 2017 and provides that a simple majority constitutes a quorum.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the office of the governor shall provide clerical and technical support as needed.

Proposed law provides for the duties, membership, and appointment of the advisory board.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the board shall elect officers, adopt bylaws, and all members shall serve without compensation.
