1	AN ACT
2	To provide relative to state highways; to designate the parallel bridges crossing the Reserve
3	Relief Canal on Interstate 10 in St. John the Baptist Parish as the "Spencer Chauvin
4	Memorial Bridge"; to designate a portion of United States Highway 190 in West
5	Baton Rouge Parish as the "Trooper Francis C. Zinna Memorial Highway"; and to
6	provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. The parallel bridges crossing the Reserve Relief Canal on Interstate 10
9	in St. John the Baptist Parish are hereby designated as the "Spencer Chauvin Memorial
10	Bridge".
11	Section 2. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, that portion of United
12	States Highway 190 in West Baton Rouge Parish from the foot of the Mississippi River
13	Bridge to its intersection with Louisiana Highway 415 is hereby designated as the "Trooper
14	Francis C. Zinna Memorial Highway".
15	Section 3. The Department of Transportation and Development is hereby directed
16	to erect and maintain appropriate signs of these designations.

<u>Proposed law</u> designates the parallel bridges crossing the Reserve Relief Canal on Interstate 10 in St. John the Baptist Parish as the "Spencer Chauvin Memorial Bridge".

<u>Proposed law</u> designates US 190 in West Baton Rouge Parish from the foot of the Mississippi River Bridge to its intersection with LA 415 as the "Trooper Francis C. Zinna Memorial Highway", notwithstanding any other law to the contrary.

Also directs DOTD to erect and maintain signs of these designations.

Effective August 1, 2017.
