Abstract: Authorizes the commissioner of insurance to seek judicial review by the district court of decisions by administrative law judges.

Present law generally prohibits any state agency, or official of the agency, from seeking judicial review of a decision by an administrative law judge.

Proposed law changes present law by authorizing the commissioner of insurance to appeal decisions by an administrative law judge involving the following:

- (1) Fines.
- (2) Revocation, denial, or suspension of any license, certificate, or registration.
- (3) Any order or directive issued pursuant to Title 22 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950.

Effective Jan. 1, 2018.
