**Abstract:** Provides that <u>present law</u> authorizing a local governing authority to amend an annual budget proposed by the chief executive or administrative officer does not apply to Lawrason Act municipalities.

<u>Present law</u> establishes a process for local governments to use in the preparation and adoption of an annual budget. Requires the chief executive or administrative officer of the local government to prepare a proposed budget and submit it to the governing authority. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the governing authority to amend the proposed budget and associated budget instrument unless otherwise provided by an ordinance or home rule charter. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that <u>present law</u> does not apply to municipalities governed by the mayor-board of aldermen form of government (the Lawrason Act).
