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SENATE BILL NO. 170

EDUCATION ACCOUNTABILITY. Provides that, for the 2016-2017 school year, students, schools, and districts in declared disaster areas shall not be negatively impacted by the school and district accountability system. (gov sig)

AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 17:24.4(F)(1)(h), relative to the school and district accountability system; to 3 provide relative to the use of student assessments in declared disaster areas for the 2016-2017 school year; and to provide for related matters. 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 6 Section 1. R.S. 17:24.4(F)(1)(h) is hereby enacted to read as follows: 7 §24.4. Louisiana Competency-Based Education Program; statewide standards for 8 required subjects; Louisiana Educational Assessment Program; parish 9 or city school board comprehensive pupil progression plans; waivers 10 A. 11 F.(1)(h) Notwithstanding the provisions of Subparagraph (g) of this Section 12 13 or any other law to the contrary, for the 2016-2017 school year, the board shall 14 collect results from the assessments administered to students but shall not use 15 the results in a manner that negatively impacts pupil placement or progression or school or district performance scores or letter grades in a parish located in 16 a gubernatorially or presidentially declared disaster area. 17

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Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.

<u>Present law</u> requires that student assessments and achievement growth data be used in the school and district accountability system. Also provides that the results from student assessments may be collected but not be used for purposes of evaluating teachers, schools, or districts during the 2016-2017 school year.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and additionally provides that notwithstanding any provisions of law to the contrary, for the 2016-2017 school year, the results from student assessments shall not be used in a manner that negatively impacts pupil placement or progression or school or district performance scores or letter grades in a parish located in a gubernatorially or presidentially declared disaster area.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
