HOUSE BILL NO. 547

MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC: Provides for an additional fee on driver's license applications to benefit the Military Family Assistance Fund

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 32:412(A)(1), (2), (5), (6), (B)(1), (2), (7)(e)(i)(aa), (cc), (dd)(I),
3 (ee), (ii)(aa), (cc), (dd)(I), and (ee) and R.S. 46:122(A)(1), relative to driver's license
4 fees; to provide for a one dollar increase in driver's license fees to benefit the
5 Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 32:412(A)(1), (2), (5), (6), (B)(1), (2), (7)(e)(i)(aa), (cc), (dd)(I), (ee),
8 (ii)(aa), (cc), (dd)(I), and (ee) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

9 §412. Amount of fees; credit or refund; duration of license; veteran designation;
10 disabled veteran designation; university logo; "I'm a Cajun" designation;
11 disbursement of funds; renewal by mail or electronic commerce of Class "D"
12 or "E" drivers' licenses; disposition of certain fees; exception

13 A.(1) Every applicant for a Class "D" driver's license, or for a renewal of a
14 Class "D" driver's license, except those bona fide residents of the city of New
15 Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of ~~forty-two~~ forty-three dollars and
16 seventy-five cents. Eleven dollars and fifteen cents of the fee shall be paid to the
17 Louisiana State Police Retirement System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee
18 shall be forwarded by the department to the litter abatement and education account
19 which is created with the Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S.

1 through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of the fee shall be paid to the
2 Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.

3 * * *

4 B.(1) Every applicant for a Class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's
5 license, or for a renewal of a basic Class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's
6 license, except for those bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for
7 such basic license a fee of ~~sixty-one~~ sixty-two dollars and fifty cents. Sixteen dollars
8 and twenty cents of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana State Police Retirement
9 System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the
10 department to the litter abatement and education account which is created within the
11 Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of the
12 fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.

13 (2) The fee for a basic Class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license,
14 or for the renewal of a basic Class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license,
15 issued to bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans shall be ~~seventy-six~~
16 seventy-seven dollars and fifty cents, fifteen dollars of which fee shall be paid by the
17 department to the board of trustees of the police pension fund of the city of New
18 Orleans. Fifteen dollars of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana State Police
19 Retirement System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by
20 the department to the litter abatement and education account which is created with
21 the Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of
22 the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.

26 (e)(i)(aa) Every applicant seventy years of age or older for a Class "E"
27 driver's license, or for the renewal of a Class "E" driver's license, except those bona
28 fide residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of ~~six~~
29 seven dollars and seventy-five cents, which shall be the cost of the license. The

1 license shall expire on the anniversary of the birthday of the applicant which is
2 nearest to a date of six years subsequent to the issuing of the license, unless revoked,
3 canceled, or suspended.

4 * * *

5 (cc) Seventy-five cents of the fee shall be paid to the office of state police.
6 Two dollars and seventy-five cents of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana State
7 Police Retirement System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be
8 forwarded by the department to the litter abatement and education account which is
9 created within the Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15).
10 One dollar of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.

11 (dd)(I) Every applicant seventy years of age or older for a Class "D" driver's
12 license, or for the renewal of a Class "D" driver's license, except those bona fide
13 residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of ~~twenty-~~
14 ~~two~~ twenty-three dollars and thirteen cents, which shall be the cost of the license.
15 The license shall expire on the anniversary of the birthday of the applicant which is
16 nearest to the date of six years subsequent to the issuing of the license, unless
17 revoked, canceled, or suspended.

19 (ee) Five dollars and fifty-six cents of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana
20 State Police Pension and Retirement System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the
21 fee shall be forwarded by the department to the litter abatement and education
22 account which is created within the Conservation Fund through the provisions of
23 R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military
24 Family Assistance Fund.

25 (ii)(aa) Every applicant seventy years of age or older for a Class "E" driver's
26 license, or for the renewal of a Class "E" driver's license, issued to bona fide
27 residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of ~~six~~
28 seven dollars and seventy-five cents, which shall be the cost of the license. This
29 license shall expire on the anniversary of the birthday of the applicant which is

1 nearest to a date of six years subsequent to the issuing of the license, unless revoked,
2 canceled, or suspended.

3 * * *

4 (cc) One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be paid to the Board of
5 Trustees of the Police Pension Fund of the city of New Orleans. One dollar and fifty
6 cents of the fee shall be paid to the State Police Pension and Retirement Fund. One
7 dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the department to the litter
8 abatement and education account which is created within the Conservation Fund
9 through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of the fee shall be paid to the
10 Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.

11 (dd)(I) Every applicant seventy years of age or older for a Class "D" driver's
12 license, or for the renewal of a Class "D" driver's license, issued to bona fide
13 residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of ~~twenty-~~
14 ~~seven~~ twenty-eight dollars and seventy-five cents, which shall be the cost of the
15 license. This license shall expire on the anniversary of the birthday of the applicant
16 which is nearest to the date of six years subsequent to the issuing of the license,
17 unless revoked, canceled, or suspended.

19 (ee) Seven dollars and fifty cents of the fee shall be payable by the
20 department to the board of trustees of the police pension fund of the city of New
21 Orleans. Ninety-two cents of the fee shall be paid to the State Police Pension and
22 Retirement Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the
23 department to the litter abatement and education account which is created within the
24 Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of the
25 fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.

27 Section 2. R.S. 46:122(A)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
28 §122. Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund

Proposed law increases the class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license fee from \$61.50 to \$62.50, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. Proposed law further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the fund.

Present law provides for a class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license fee of \$76.50 for residents of the city of New Orleans. Present law further provides for the distribution of the fee according to present law.

Proposed law increases the class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license fee from \$76.50 to \$77.50 for residents of the city of New Orleans. Proposed law further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the fund.

Present law provides for applicants 70 years or older a class "E" driver's license fee of \$6.75, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. Present law further provides for the distribution of the fee according to present law.

Proposed law increases the fee for applicants 70 years or older for a class "E" driver's license from \$6.75 to \$7.75, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. Proposed law further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the fund.

Present law provides for applicants 70 years or older a class "D" driver's license fee of \$22.13, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. Present law further provides for the distribution of the fee according to present law.

Proposed law increases the fee for applicants 70 years or older for a class "D" driver's license from \$22.13 to \$23.13, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. Proposed law further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the fund.

Present law provides for applicants 70 years or older, and a resident of the city of New Orleans, a class "E" driver's license fee of \$6.75. Present law further provides for the distribution of the fee according to present law.

Proposed law increases the fee for applicants 70 years or older, and a resident of the city of New Orleans, for a class "E" driver's license from \$6.75 to \$7.75. Proposed law further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the fund.

Present law provides for applicants 70 years or older, and a resident of the city of New Orleans, a class "D" driver's license fee of \$27.75. Present law further provides for the distribution of the fee according to present law.

Proposed law increases the fee for applicants 70 years or older, and a resident of the city of New Orleans, for a class "D" driver's license from \$27.75 to \$28.75. Proposed law further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the fund.

Present law provides for funds received pursuant to present law to be deposited to the La. Military Family Assistance Fund.

Proposed law adds the revenue derived from proposed law to the funds deposited in the La. Military Family Assistance Fund.
