Abstract: Requires the Louisiana Geological Survey to review and revise the statewide flood information database at least once every three years. Requires the governing authority of a municipality or parish to submit an application to the office of engineering if a disaster declaration has been issued by the governor for that municipality or parish.

<u>Present law</u> requires the La. Geological Survey to review and revise the statewide flood information data base at least once very four years.

<u>Proposed law</u> modifies <u>present law</u> by changing the time frame <u>from</u> once every four years <u>to</u> once every three years.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that if the La. Geological Survey does not review and revise the statewide flood information database as required in <u>present law</u>, they must provide a reason to the House and Senate committees on Transportation explaining the failure. <u>Proposed law</u> allows the committee to request the governing authority of the La. Geological Survey withhold appropriations to the survey until the review and revisions are complete.

<u>Present law</u> provides that any duly authorized municipal, parish, or other governing authority may submit an application for funding of any flood-control projects under the Statewide Flood Control Plan to the office of engineering by October 1st of each year.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that if a disaster declaration has been issued by the governor for a municipality or parish, the governing authority of that municipality or parish must submit an application as provided for in <u>present law</u> by October 1st of the year following the declaration.
