| 7 | WHEREAS, Mr. Lemelle received his bachelor's degree from Grambling State |
| 8 | University in education and his master's degree and thirty additional graduate level classes |
| 9 | from Southern University; and |
| 10 | WHEREAS, Clifton Lemelle Sr. devoted thirty-six years of his life to the education |
| 11 | and the nurturing of the boys and girls of St. Landry Parish as a teacher, coach, and |
| 12 | administrator; and |
| 13 | WHEREAS, Mr. Lemelle strives to embody his personal philosophy that states, |
| 14 | "Strong faith and integrity will enable one to meet the challenges of serving humanity", and |
| 15 | he leads by example, modeling this philosophy in his teaching career and his life in St. |
| 16 | Landry Parish; and |
| 17 | WHEREAS, Clifton Lemelle Sr. has lead a wide range of organizations throughout |

| 9 | works to champion the civil rights of individuals and groups primarily in St. Landry Parish; |

| 11 | WHEREAS, Mr. Lemelle has held membership in many civic, civil rights, and |
| 12 | military organizations, including the Veterans' of Foreign Wars Post 3786, past member of |
| 13 | the Louisiana State Commission on the Education of Student Drop-outs, and past member |
| 14 | of the Louisiana State Commission on Teacher Certification and Evaluation; and |
| 15 | WHEREAS, Clifton Lemelle Sr. has received numerous awards and commendations, |
| 16 | including: St. Landry Parish School Board award for distinguished service, the Martin |
| 17 | Luther King Jr. Award presented by the city of Eunice by proclamation on "Clifton Lemelle |
| 18 | Day" in March, 2003, African American Hall of Fame inductee, and the St. Landry branch |
| 19 | of NAUW's award for "Leading the Struggle against Racism"; and |
| 20 | WHEREAS, Clifton Lemelle Sr. has spoken to various organizations and educational |
| 21 | institutions across the state and the nation, and has conducted educational seminars on school |
| 22 | desegregation, racism in the workplace, and affirmative action; and |
| 23 | WHEREAS, true to his mission of serving his fellow man, Clifton Lemelle continues |
| 24 | to mentor young educators, youth of the community, and civil rights activists throughout |
| 25 | Louisiana always remaining true to his personal philosophy that "strong faith and integrity |
| 26 | will enable one to meet the challenges of serving humanity"; a mantra that Clifton Lemelle |
| 27 | has proven everyday to the people of St. Landry Parish and beyond; and |
