COMMENDATIONS: Commends the Lutcher High School Bulldogs football team upon winning the 2016 Class 3A state championship

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend the Lutcher High School football team upon winning the 2016 Class 3A state
3 championship.

4 WHEREAS, for the second straight year, the Lutcher High School football team has
5 earned the Class 3A football championship title in Louisiana; and

6 WHEREAS, the Bulldogs of Lutcher High School were led by first-year coach
7 Dwain Jenkins, a former Lutcher quarterback, to a 13-2 season that culminated in a
8 December 10, 2016, LHSAA Prep Classic showdown at the Mercedes-Benz Superdome in
9 New Orleans against Amite High School; and

10 WHEREAS, down by two points at halftime, senior quarterback Jontre Kirklin drove
11 the Lutcher Bulldogs to outscore their opponents by a margin of fourteen points in the third
12 quarter to take control of the game; Kirklin piled up 223 yards on the ground, passed for 158
13 yards, and scored four total touchdowns to earn the Most Outstanding Player award for
14 Lutcher High School; and

15 WHEREAS, this thrilling 40-36 victory marked the Bulldogs' eighth Class 3A state
16 football championship, its first repeat, and the culmination of a memorable first season for
17 Coach Jenkins, his staff, and players; and

18 WHEREAS, the members of the team performed at the highest level of excellence
19 throughout the 2016 regular season and the playoffs, and each of these talented Bulldogs
