COURTS: Provides for a mayor's court in the village of Athens

2	To enact R.S. 33:457, relative to mayor's courts; to establish a mayor's court in the village
3	of Athens in Claiborne Parish; to provide for territorial jurisdiction; to provide for
4	the powers and authority of the mayor as magistrate of the court and other officers
5	of the court; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 33:457 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§457. Mayor's court; village of Athens
9	A. There is hereby created the Mayor's Court of the village of Athens, the
10	territorial jurisdiction of which shall extend throughout the village of Athens in
11	Claiborne Parish.
12	B. The general provisions of R.S. 33:441 and 442 shall be applicable to and
13	shall govern and regulate the Mayor's Court of the village of Athens, the jurisdiction
14	of the court, and the powers and authority of the mayor and other officers of the
15	court.

**Abstract:** Establishes the Mayor's Court of the village of Athens in Claiborne Parish.
